Meet the Tidwell's

When these sheep came to the ministry 18 months ago, they were broken and scattered. The married couple was separated and their two youngest children, Noah and Aahron were in foster care. Their daughter, Sasha, was living with a legal guardian out of state, and their teen son (not pictured) was living in rebellion. Corey was a methamphetamine addict for over 20 years and Natalie was addicted for five years. Their past was stained with adultery, abuse, multiple incarcerations, homelessness, tragic deaths of children, suicide of a family member, mental illness, physical ailments, religious spirits, doctrines of demons, and domestic violence.

With much prayer, the laying on of hands for healing and casting out devils, discipleship, pastoral counseling, and solid teaching of God's Word, we witnessed Jesus doing a mighty miracle in this

family. First, the Lord restored Corey and Natalie's marriage. Then, God re-united them with their youngest children who were released from Child Protective Services into their legal custody. Natalie was baptized with the Holy Spirit in 2020 with the evidence of speaking in tongues. The Lord healed her from many physical ailments and from diagnosed mental illness. In April 2021, we celebrated another miracle. Sasha, who had been away from Natalie's custody since 2016 was restored into her care miraculously. The judge testified saying, "This was the fastest and smoothest" reunification case he had ever been on as a family court judge. Just this month, Corey was baptized in the Holy Spirit and began speaking in tongues. He was anointed as an evange-list and began to share Jesus with people at the gas station and wherever he was. He since joined with Minister Luis to go hand out burritos and share the gospel in the streets of Bakersfield. Corey and Natalie remain clean off drugs for over a year and by God's grace, Corey stopped smoking this month as well. Natalie serves on the praise and worship team at church and they both love serving at our homeless outreach events. Pray that each of them will run their race with endurance. Pray for Joseph, the oldest son who is drawing near to the gospel but is still resisting. Pray he turns to God and is saved!

Crystal came to Christ in October 2020 and was baptized in water in November 2020. She immediately began attending Wednesday night and Sunday morning services faithfully and studying the Bible with the woman who introduced her to Christ. At the time, she was living with her child's father, Valdez, although they were not married. After coming to Christ, Crystal began seeking first the kingdom of God and in April 2021, she was baptized in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. Crystal wrote, "I'm convinced God can do it all! What I have been trying to "fix" for YEARS, He has done in a matter of just six months! Everything from

casting out doubt to quitting tobacco, to the courage to ask the man I shared my life with for the last four years to leave my house because I knew it wasn't right in the eyes of the Lord...When I put God first, it almost seemed effortless. He is changing my life EVERY SINGLE DAY, and I wouldn't want it any other way." In April, the man she loves, Valdez, moved in to the *Man Up Men's Home*, surrendered his life to Jesus, and began seeking God earnestly; he even had an encounter with angels. After Bible study this Wednesday, Valdez got on his knee and proposed to Crystal. "I am now engaged to be married to the father of my child and the man I fell in love with four years ago. Except THIS time, we are walking with Jesus together. Thank you Father!" ~ Crystal.



Make disciples...

Minister Monique (Moe) was called into ministry in 2016. The Lord gave her a passion to serve teens and young adults. In 2018, she received prayer ministry and was delivered from a spirit of shame and was baptized in the Holy Spirit. She began to serve with KPM ministering to people in need. She also began ministering to young adults with the authority of her pastor in 2019, but after a short time she forfeited her assignment, caving to spirits of fear, doubt, and insecurity. In 2021, the Lord rekindled her fire to speak into the lives of teens and young adults . Her anointing was made clear at a recent youth retreat and now she is training young adults and teens to be used to pray for others and serve the body of Christ. Those under her wing are growing and maturing in their love for Christ. We have witnessed authentic transformation, as several teens have confessed and been delivered from sexual sin, bondage to pornography, eating disorders, depression, anxiety, drug addictions, abuse, rebellion, and insecurities. At their youth group nights, the teens spend about an hour worshipping God, praying for one another, and reading God's Word. The majority of teens have been baptized with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of



speaking in tongues. Monique is raising up leaders and is currently working closely with one young adult who is helping her prepare lessons and is being used to minister to the younger children. Pray for this dynamic duo to reach many youth for Jesus Christ. Pray specifically for the junior high trip this weekend. They are praying that God's authentic love will cast out all fears, manifesting in a true sense of security in their identity rooted and established in the love of Jesus Christ.
